This individual is responsible for interpreter assignments for Deaf and Hard of Hearing people and for developing contracts with outside interpreters/agencies. Also collaborates with educational institutions to provide valuable practicum experiences for interpreting students. Assists in training and language development specific to the needs of Deaf or Hard of Hearing individuals. Schedule varies. 35 hours per week.
